A&MARSC Only Exchange: Vrije Universiteit (Netherlands)

Deadlines to Apply are March I for Fall 2025 and September I for Spring 2026

OVERVIEW

Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam (VU), is a public research university in the Zuidas District of Amsterdam, recognized among the top 150 universities in the world. Founded in 1880, the VU enrolls approximately 29,000 students and prides itself as a multidisciplinary collection of free thinkers who together will build a better world for the planet and its people. Amsterdam, where Vrije University is located, is the capital and the largest city in the Netherlands. The metropolitan area is home to around 2.4 million people, 75 museums, 350 festivals a year, and a picturesque 17th central canal ring. The city is within easy traveling distance of London, Paris, Barcelona, Berlin, and Brussels.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all TAMU students enrolled in the College of Arts and Sciences
- Have a minimum TAMU GPA of 3.0
- Be a TAMU student for at least one semester prior to application
- Attend TAMU for at least one full semester after the exchange
- All students must be in <u>Good Academic</u>
 <u>Standing</u> and <u>Good Conduct Standing</u> with
 Texas A&M University to participate in
 education abroad programs.
- Please check with the provider/host institution for any course pre- or corequisites requirements (if applicable).

COURSEWORK

Course offerings at VU are available here <u>Exchange Program Courses</u>. VU Amsterdam uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Exchange students typically enroll in 30 ECTS per semester, but must take a minimum of 24 ECTS. Most courses are 6 ECTS credits. 6 ECTS generally equates to 3 TAMU credit hours.

Spring 2026: February 2 - June 26, 2026

Annual Year: September 1, 2025 - June 26, 2026

ESTIMATED COSTS
